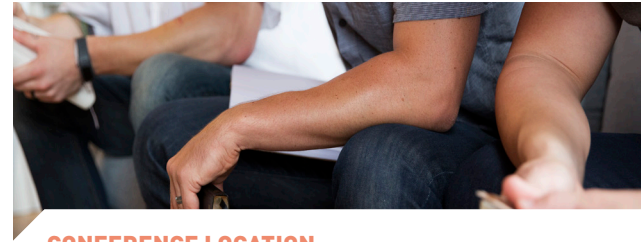
STRENGTHENING YOUR MINISTRY WITH MEN, YOUNG MEN, AND BOYS
